The term *epiphany* means "to show" or "to make known" or even "to reveal." The colours to Epiphany are usually the colours of Christmas, white and gold - the colours of celebration, newness, and hope - that mark the most sacred days of the church year. The colours are often changed after Epiphany to the colours of Ordinary Time, usually **green** or thematic sanctuary colours, until Transfiguration Sunday, which is the last Sunday before the beginning of Lent. The colours for Transfiguration Sunday are usually the colours of Holy Days, white and gold.
