2023 has been another very busy year for bookings with nineteen regular hirers on a weekly, fortnightly and monthly basis. In addition, private bookings stand at an average of fifty per annum. One of the highlights of the year came in May when the Hall played a central role in the Coronation celebrations.

The final building work on the extension was completed in the first couple of months of the year and the new Clent Connect Hub was officially opened on 11 March 2023.
