August. VJ Day ringing, 12 bell practice at Stourbridge and support given by Clent ringers for weddings at Wollaston, Hagley and Belbroughton.


September. Martin helped to ring for a wedding at Kingswinford, as well as a wedding at St Leonard's. We welcomed a visiting band.
