The design and format have remained constant and so frequent visitors know what to expect and where to find things_

#1 a welcoming <Homepage> which has general information about the parish and its activities and which lists our services each month

It also includes the required display of contact information regarding Safeguarding

#2 <Services> page which carries more detailed information about each service

#3 <Prayers> page which carries the Diocesan Podcast for that week, the Collect and Intercessions we use each Sunday, the Bible Readings and Diocesan Prayers

#4 <Worship> page with an OpenCast service which people can read through and participate in at will, together with a traditional hymn and a contemporary Worship Song

#5 <Contacts> page which lists the people you might need to get in touch with and their e.mail and phone numbers

#6 <Council> page for the P.C.C. members to receive the paperwork for meetings and to hold larger documents which would be expensive to print and circulate. It also allows all members of the congregation to discover the topics raised and debated and the decisions taken by their representatives.
